HOW TO USE

- PULL A CARD**
Pick a card or choose a category.
- TAKE TURNS**
Share honestly. Listen without fixing.
- GO DEEPER**
Ask follow-up questions. Be real.
- PRAY TOGETHER**
Lift each other up. Keep each other accountable.



HEART
What's really going on inside?

- 1 What's been on your heart lately?
- 2 Where are you struggling most right now?
- 3 What's something you're afraid to admit or ask for help with?



FAITH
Growing in your walk with God.

- 1 What has God been teaching you lately?
- 2 How are you spending time with God?
- 3 Where do you sense God inviting you to grow or step out?



HABITS
The daily choices that shape you.

- 1 What's one habit that's helping you grow?
- 2 What's one habit that's holding you back?
- 3 How can we help each other live with discipline and integrity?



RELATIONSHIPS
Building better connections.

- 1 How are things in your marriage or family?
- 2 Who in your life do you need to forgive or reconnect with?
- 3 How can we better support and challenge each other?



PURPOSE
Living on mission.

- 1 How do you see God using you right now?
- 2 What's one way you can serve or make an impact this week?
- 3 What legacy do you want to leave behind?



ACCOUNTABILITY
Keeping each other on track.

- 1 What's something you want me to hold you accountable for?
- 2 Have you been honest and pure in your thoughts and actions?
- 3 Where have you been compromising? What's your next step?

TIPS FOR GREAT CONVERSATIONS

- Be present. Put away distractions.
- Listen more than you talk.
- Speak the truth in love.
- Keep what's shared, shared.
- Follow up and check in.
